- In 2018 the graduate and postgraduate employment rate (87.7% and 87.4%) were substantially higher than the employment rate of non-graduates (71.6%) (Graduate labour market statistics 2018 (Glasnik, April 2017))

 - Diploma in International Studies

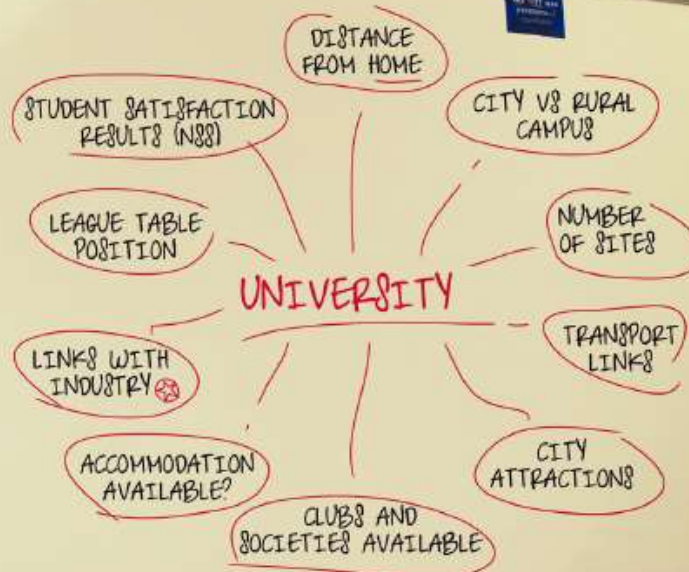
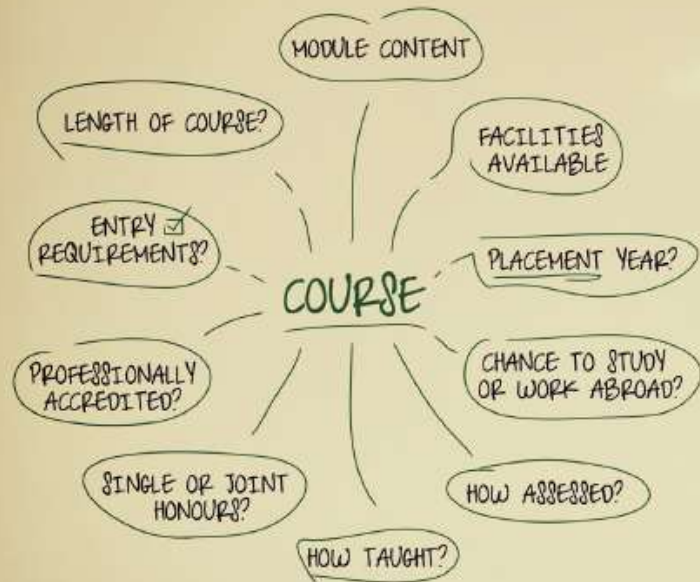
