

Sixth Form Uniform Code 2020

School Uniform –Smart Business Dress

- Blazer or tailored jacket (such as a suit jacket) to be worn at all times (optional for Year 13).
- Shirt with collar or smart blouse or plain polo shirt
- Knitted jumper free from any logos - optional (to be worn with a jacket/blazer and collared shirt).
- Tailored trousers which must be of an 'office' style
- Formal blouse or smart top
- Skirt or dress, of suitable material and length (no more than 5cm above the knee) in an 'office' style
- Tie – optional
- Waistcoat - optional
- Smart, plain belts – optional
- Plain black, grey or neutral tights - optional
- Shoes or boots; smart leather or leather style, flat or with a low heel (up to 5cm)

PLEASE NOTE:

- Trousers – unacceptable items include: Jeans (of any colour or type), hipsters, cargo style, tight jeggings, any coloured external labelling and those with studs or zipped front pockets.
- Tight 'skinny' trousers or leggings are not permitted.
- Jackets – leather or denim jackets, or bomber jackets are not acceptable in school. Coats of any sort are not allowed to be worn inside the school building.
- Hooded Tops must not be worn in school.
- Crop tops, low cut tops, and vest tops are not appropriate in school.
- Sweaters must not have logos. T-shirts are not permitted.
- Shoes must not have logos or writing on them. Trainers of any type, heavy boots, Ugg type boots and canvas shoes are inappropriate footwear and must not be worn.
- Extreme hairstyles, excessive jewellery and/or excessive make-up are not permitted
- Facial piercings, including nose and eyebrow studs are not permitted.

If any student is unsure about a particular item of clothing, they should seek clarification from the Sixth Form team.

Any student reporting for Sixth Form who does not adhere to the dress code will be asked to go home and return wearing appropriate clothing. Persistent failure to adhere to our expectations could result in students working in isolation and, ultimately, losing their place in the Sixth Form.
