Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

Please find enclosed your child's full Year 13 report. The document outlines their Target Grade, which is based on the grades that they were awarded for their Key Stage 4 qualifications. The document also includes a 'mock grade' which is the grade achieved in the recent mock examination only. It does not take into account any coursework or controlled assessment. The Working at Grade (WAG) is the grade that all of your child's work to-date has been awarded, including the recent mock examination. The prediction is what the teacher for each subject area believes your child is on track to achieve if there is continued improvement and once the course has been completed and any necessary support and intervention has taken place.

If your child studies Applied Science, IT, Performing Arts or Sport then these subjects are graded as pass (P), merit (M) or distinction (D).

Examinations are due to proceed as planned in the summer term of 2022 and further details have been released to explain what amendments are going to made in each subject to take into consideration the disruption caused by the pandemic. The report also includes an 'attitude to learning' grade which is on a scale of 1 to 4. This takes into account the level of effort and commitment applied to an individual's studies in lessons, as well as their completion of homework and wider independent study. A grade of 1 indicates that a student is doing everything that is required of them inside and outside lessons, often going above and beyond expectations. A grade of 4 would indicate that there are serious concerns about the efforts of an individual and that this is having an impact on their progress.
