Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

Year 13 Examinations Information

The final examinations for Year 13 students begin on Monday 16th May. In advance of this, the information below outlines some of the key arrangements.

Students have been given a timetable for their examinations and should arrive no later than 8.30am for morning examinations so that they can enter the exam hall by 8.45am. Students will need to report to the sports hall by 12.45pm for afternoon examinations so that they can start by 1pm. Once an afternoon exam has finished, students will be expected to leave the school site. Any students who are waiting for school transport can study in the library until the end of the normal school day.

Students are expected to attend school as normal during examinations up until May half term, apart from in the following situation: students are not expected to attend a lesson occurring in the session prior to an exam. For example, if students have an afternoon exam, they are not required to attend in the morning. If students have a morning exam, they are not required to attend lessons during the previous day.

After May half-term, week beginning 6th June, students are only expected to continue to attend for lessons where they have not yet completed their final exam in that subject. Students will need to sign in at main reception when they arrive for lessons and out upon leaving for fire evacuation and safeguarding reasons. Please note that the 20th June is an Inset day. Exams on this day will take place as scheduled and students will be able to access the site through the pupil gates. Please note that there will be no buses running on this day.

Students should report to their designated room in good time for their exams and should absolutely not be late. Late arrival could mean that your child is unable to sit their examination. Each student has been given a timetable, however, an electronic version can be downloaded from the school website.

The leavers' assembly will take place on Friday 20th May. It will begin at 2pm in the Sixth Form Centre and lessons will run as normal in the morning. We would love to see all of the students in attendance. A-Level results day this year is on Thursday 18th August and the school will be open at 9am. Students should go to the Sixth Form Centre to collect their results and further details with all arrangements will be sent out towards the end of term. Please also continue to monitor the school website.

The past two years have been far from ideal for our current Year 13 cohort, however, we are proud of the levels of application and determination that each and every one of them has shown in completing their studies. There is still lots of hard work and preparation to come, however, we wish all of them the very best in their final exams.
