


The Know, Do, Review Cycle

At Chase Terrace Academy, teaching and learning follows the "Know, Do, Review" cycle. Teachers share essential core knowledge with students prior to the lesson, via knowledge organisers, providing a "big picture" overview and the foundation for challenging activities.

Sharing this key knowledge also enables you as parents to play a role in supporting your child with their learning.



Know

For our staff, this is about knowing your child and knowing what their needs are so that they can best cater for them in class. For your child, this is about developing a deep body of knowledge around the subject that they are in and making sure that they know what their strengths and areas of development are. For

you as parents, this is about you knowing what your child is currently studying and supporting them with the knowledge organiser home learning.

Do

This is about your child "having a go" in every lesson, attempting all tasks and completing them to the highest standard possible. It also includes completing the home learning that is set and this is where parents come in. Evidence shows that in order to learn something, and retain in, students must actively do something with that knowledge – teaching someone at home what they have done that day at school is one of the most effective ways of learning.

Review

Students will be given regular opportunities in school to revisit and check their prior learning through low stakes quizzing and assessments. A key part of the process will be taking time to review what they have done each day and reflect on it so that they know what they need to do next.
