Social care workers could be supporting someone with a range of disabilities, dementia, or mental health conditions. They also work in a variety of settings, including care homes, in the local community, or from a care seeker's home.

There are lots of different roles in social care depending on what you want to do, who you want to work with and where you'd like to work.

Julie Saunders - Physiotherapy Technical Instructor, Sue Ryder

Julie manages the daily running of the physiotherapy department at Sue Ryder, delivering prescribed physiotherapy treatments to long term patients who have suffered a brain injury. Julie often supports work experience students who come to Sue Ryder, helping them to gain a clear understanding of the benefits of the different opportunities and roles available to them.

Magda Kaczorowska – Curriculum Facilitator, Leonard Cheshire

Magda is a member of the Learning and Development (L&D) team at Leonard Cheshire, a caregiving service provider for people with disabilities. She started her journey as a Support Worker and moved into L&D 8 years ago, developing and delivering training that enables staff to gain the knowledge they need for their job. Over her career, she has seen colleagues start careers as Support Workers and develop into Managers; Nurses; and Physiotherapists. She is an advocate for the sector and would passionately encourage young people to consider it.

Lynn Bassett – Manager (Warwickshire Learning and Development Partnership), Warwickshire County Council

Lynn manages the Warwickshire Learning and Development Partnership which supports social care business to develop staff and improve service quality. The Partnership also offers advice and guidance to services, as well as commissioning training and offering bursaries. Lynn has supported young people throughout her offer, from offering work experience opportunities and employing apprentices.

Sarah Drummond – Team Leader (Reablement Service), Newcastle City Council

Sarah moved into the care sector from finance after wanting a career change. She started by supporting adults with learning difficulties, before moving to Newcastle City Council, overseeing Care Officers for the Reablement Service – providing short-term support to adults in their homes. She now works as the Team Leader for the service and has launched a Health and Social Care Academy in Newcastle, worked on the integration of local hospitals and community teams, and oversees a team of officers and coordinators.

Steph Lee - Housing & Care Manager, Housing 21

Steph is a CQC registered manager, responsible for the operational management and quality of the care service at Housing 21. She ensure that the organisation is running a safe service and all performance measures are met, in line with industry standards. She is passionate about ensuring that residents receive a high quality of care and housing.

56. STEM skills shortage 2022- Combatting the STEM Skills Shortage in 2022

Mechanical Engineering- Mechanical engineers make things work the way they are supposed to work, and they are inventors and innovators. They design and develop valuable technologies and machinery that advance our communities and improve our way of life. These products range from sports cars to prosthetic limbs and 3D printers.

In short, mechanical engineers create and operate the technological world around you.

The UK is experiencing a science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) skills shortage. According to a study by the Engineering Design Show, over 50% of engineering firms find it difficult to recruit and retain staff with the skills and knowledge necessary for the job. In response to this, the government is investing millions of pounds into STEM education. This means mechanical engineering will be more accessible for aspiring scientists from all backgrounds.

As of March 2021, the average salary for an entry-level Mechanical Engineering role in the UK is £36,092, ranging between £25,429 and £43,111. With the investments in STEM education and the 10% rise in wages, there has never been a better time to embark on a mechanical engineering course.

This article will explore the importance of mechanical engineers across various industries, including power plants, automotive, and aerospace.

Power plant engineers- To begin, mechanical engineers are responsible for the systems and components design, operation, and management of power plants. There are many types of power plants, including nuclear, hydroelectric, geothermal, solar, wind, tidal. Each power plant converts energy to electricity differently. Mechanical engineers collaborate with civil, chemical, and electrical power engineers to design, build, and operate power plants. Power

This will mean British electricity supply will move away from gas and fossil fuels, focusing instead on nuclear, wind, and solar energy. These renewable sources work much differently than fossil fuels, so the way we use electricity in buildings and manufacturing and even transport will need to be redesigned. Therefore, the role of mechanical engineers is as important as ever as the nation races against time to produce environmentally friendly energy.

Automotive engineers- Mechanical engineers can also work within the automotive sector. Engineers in this industry work with a number of vehicles, including cars, motorbikes, bicycles, and buses. Automotive engineers can work on all the different vehicle systems, like engines, batteries, gears, interior and exterior styling, materials, and brakes. They are skilled at designing blueprints for vehicle components, as well as building and rigorously testing them. Moreover, automotive engineers must be skilled at interpreting data, writing in-depth reports, and liaising with suppliers. Therefore, all engineers must be able to work both independently and within a team. This is a diverse role that is perfect for someone who lives life in the fast lane.

The UK government has pledged to ban all carbon dioxide-emitting cars by 2050. This will transform the nature of automotive engineering, and transportation on the whole. Therefore, mechanical engineers have never been more important to the automotive industry. The future of automobiles is electric, and considering electric cars save up to 1.5 million grams of carbon dioxide in one year, we can see why.

Aerospace and aeronautical engineers- Aerospace engineering is a sector of mechanical engineering that specialises in space technologies, as well as systems of technologies for aircraft that operate within the earth's atmosphere.

These positions encompass a wide variety of jobs, from designing aeroplanes to ensuring that rocket engines use the exact amount of fuel when launching into space, although there are many transferable skills between each role. The daily tasks of aerospace and aeronautical engineers include building navigation systems, testing prototypes, planning and build aircraft components, and much more.

Aerospace and aeronautical engineers are invaluable in contemporary society. Their expert knowledge ensures the correct placement of satellites, safe passage of holiday-goers, and exploration into outer space. And with the UK government investing £1.87 billion into a European space agency, we don't see this changing any time soon.

Overall, the importance of mechanical engineering has never been greater. As Britain attempts to lower carbon emissions, young engineers represent the future of science. There has never been a better time to become a mechanical engineer.
