

## Festival - Food.

The main school will be closed for the day of the festival so all food purchases will be made on the school field.

There will be no facility for our normal digital payment methods so we request that pupils are given cash to pay on the day. This is a one-off request

Pupils who receive free school meals will be given a voucher card on the day of the festival so that they can purchase food using the voucher.

## Pricing is as follows:

Chip station with toppings (cheese, curry sauce etc) all	£1
Burgers and hot dogs (beef and vegetarian/ pork and vegan)	£3/£2
Pizza station – assorted pizzas from	£1
Sweet station – assorted muffins/doughnuts/popcorn/waffles	£1-£1.30

If you would prefer not to use this system then please send your child in with a festival picnic. A reminder that we are trying to be as eco-friendly as possible so your child must not have glass bottles in their picnic - these will be removed on bag searches at the turnstiles.

In addition, as a community, we would be grateful for your support with our ecofriendly theme and that:

Plastic bottles are kept to a minimum (there will be 5 stations to refill bottles with water placed around the festival site). Ideally, we would prefer pupils to bring in a bottle that they already use on a daily basis.

Plastic packaging is not used to wrap up picnic items if possible. Please make use of reusable packaging whenever this is viable.

We will have two ice cream vans on site. With this in mind, pupils with any type of food allergy are recommended not to use this facility. Unfortunately, the voucher system cannot be used at this facility.
