



As part of the Chase Terrace Festival one of the opportunities for the afternoon is to bring your own tent to put up in your Year group Camping Zone.

You can bring any of the following at your own risk:

A small tent that you can carry and put up yourself

A camping chair to sit on

A picnic blanket to sit on

We ask that you do not take the tent or chairs into school before the Festival. Instead you have one of the following options:

1. Bring in your equipment on Monday 17th between 3.30 – 6.30

Arrangements:

You and your parent guardian need to:

Label equipment with your child's name and form and attach a ribbon or something distinctive that allows you to recognise your tent quickly.

Evening

- ✓ Bring the tent to the PE office where you will be met by PE staff. We, will show you where to store your tent for the evening. It will be housed in the sports hall.
 - ✓ Your child will collect their tent once they have received their wristband and have had their bag checked (as normal festival protocol).
 - ✓ Your child will take their own tent / chair to their Year Group Zone and will need to put it up themselves
- 2. Bring your equipment in the evening as option 1. You can then put the tent up and leave it overnight.**
- ✓ The school gates will be locked, but the tents will be left without any supervision and at your own risk.

A member of staff will be in the Year group zone at all times.

3. Bring your equipment on the day of the event between 7 am – 8am

Morning

- ✓ Bring your tent to the PE office where you will be met. We will show you to your Year Group Zone.
- ✓ If you have time you may put your tent up before going to form, but will need to leave the field by 8.15.

End of the event.

The event will finish at 2.50

You child will have until 4. 0 clock to remove the tent from the Festival area.

The field will need to be clear ready for the Summer Concert in the evening

PLEASE NOTE:

All equipment is brought in at your own risk. Please do not send in equipment that is valuable.

We will have members of staff patrolling the tent areas but damage to equipment, although not anticipated, will not be the responsibility of the school.
