## CORRECT UNIFORM

## Shoes

Black leather shoes shown below


## Girls



No sports shoes or trainers with sports logos or branding are allowed.
School Navy Blazer and Tie - Navy blue V neck knitted jumper (no logos) can be worn under the blazer. Ties are specific to school houses.


Trousers should be grey school trousers - not skinny or jeans type, stretch material or cropped. Alternatively, pupils can wear the branded school skirt (worn at the correctly length).


## General appearance

- No extreme hairstyles/buzz cuts/designs cut into hair, hair must be a natural colour
- No facial piercings - nose studs/tongue bars, only stud type earring in each ear is allowed. Jewellery such as necklaces should not be worn.
- No nail extensions or false nails
- KS3 - Y7, 8, 9 no make up to be worn KS4 - Y10 and 11 - discreet, natural make up, no false eyelashes/extensions.
- Black tights or knee length socks to be worn with skirts (ankle socks over tights are not allowed)
- Hoodies are not allowed to be worn on site (PE hoodies only to be worn for PE and not around the school building)

If you have any difficulty in purchasing uniform, please contact your Year team for support.
Where pupils do not wear the correct uniform, uniform will be supplied to use for the day, if a pupil refuses this will escalate to a sanction. All uniform provided is clean and washed, or new.
