**RE: YEAR 10 MOCK EXAMINATIONS**

From Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June, our Year 10 students will begin their end-of-year examinations. As part of this, students will sit papers in almost all of their subjects.

The main focus of the examinations is to provide students and staff with an indication of where good progress is being made and where further work is needed; it is also an opportunity for students to get used to sitting examinations in a formal setting. These examinations present an excellent opportunity for everyone to review what needs to be done ahead of the start of Year 11.

The exams will take place in the sports hall and students have received an assembly to provide further details on the process as well as some guidance on revision strategies. Students will be supported in individual subject areas with specific revision activities and this work will be set through show my homework. Planning revision is key and there is a document on the website to support this along with a range of other guidance – students have also been given a blank revision planner.
