Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: SPORTS DAY

Our Annual Sports Day will be held on **Thursday 4th July 2024** for Years 7 – 10. All pupils are required to come to school wearing their correct CTA PE kit and will register at 8.30am:

- Year 9 & 10 – **will register on the fields** and complete their sports day events until 10.30am
- Year 7 & 8 – **will register in their form rooms** before their sports day events 10.50-12.50pm
- Pupils will be in their form rooms completing Personal Development activities for the other time slots when they are not competing.
- All pupils will then be on the field 1.30-3pm for the finals, relays, and presentations.

The canteen will be serving food as normal at break and lunch, but it is recommended that pupils bring a packed lunch where possible. The event will finish at 3pm for the normal end of school.

To support your child on the day we wish to advise you and your child of the following information regarding PE kit: Pupils should wear regulation CTA PE kit to school (as made clear on the school website under policies) with the addition of a Blue or Black sports tracksuit or CTA PE Hoody for comfort if desired. Combat trousers, beach wear, short cycling shorts or three-quarter length trousers etc are unacceptable attire and pupils who are not dressed appropriately will not be able to participate. When competing, pupils must wear regulation summer PE kit (without tracksuit unless medical evidence supplied). Where there are issues with obtaining CTA PE kit, can pupils please make the school aware as we have spare clothing to borrow, or the CATCH hub is available to support anyone in need. Arrangements need to be made before the deadline of **Monday 1st July** to ensure all pupils are correctly clothed for the day.

The changing rooms will not be secured during the day and there will be no provision for collecting jewellery or valuables. Please ensure your child leaves these items at home as we cannot be responsible for any losses. In the event of a hot and sunny day your child should bring sunscreen, sensible hat, and water in a plastic container. There will be water stations provided for pupils to refill their water bottles if required. If the weather is cold and/or damp; a waterproof coat, trousers, and plastic bag to sit on are recommended. If weather is extremely poor; Sports Day will be cancelled, and pupils will have their normal timetabled lessons.

We expect our pupils to demonstrate the highest standards of behaviour at all times and represent themselves, their form and their houses with Respect, Community, Tenacity and Aspiration. Alternative provision will be provided for pupils unable to meet these expectations. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide capacity for parents/family to watch but we will take photographs and publicise where possible. Thank you for your support and we look forward to hosting another successful Sports Day at Chase Terrace Academy.
