## Mon uniforme

Pour aller au collège – for school  
 Je porte – I wear  
 Les garçons portent – the boys wear  
 Les filles portent – the girls wear  
 une veste – a jacket  
 une jupe – a skirt  
 une chemise – a shirt  
 une cravate – a tie  
 un pull – a pullover  
 un pantalon - trousers  
 un collant - tights  
 des chaussettes - socks  
 des chaussures - shoes  
 des baskets - trainers  
 bleu marine – navy blue  
 bleu clair – light blue  
 à rayures - stripy

In English, 'trousers' and 'jeans' are plural but in French they are singular: **un pantalon** and **un jean**.



## Studio Grammaire

Page 44

**on** is the most commonly used word for 'we' in French. It has the same verb form as *il/elle*.  
 With regular *-er* verbs, the verb ends in **e**.

	<i>-er</i> verbs (e.g. <i>bavarder</i> – to chat)	<i>avoir</i> (to have)	<i>être</i> (to be)
<i>il/elle/on</i>	<b>bavarde</b>	a	est

À la récré, on bavarde. At breaktime, we chat.  
 On a cours. We have lessons.  
 On est fatigués. We are tired.

Remember, **-s** at the end of words is silent, so **noir** and **noirs** both sound the same.

The colours **vert** and **gris** sound different in the feminine form.

*un polo vert* → *une jupe verte*  
*un polo gris* → *une jupe grise*



Most adjectives, including colours, come after the noun. The adjective must agree with the noun.

masculine singular	<b>un pull vert</b>
feminine singular	<b>une jupe verte</b>
masculine plural	<b>des polos verts</b>
feminine plural	<b>des chaussures vertes</b>

*blanc* is irregular:

**un pull blanc** / **une jupe blanche**

**j'adore lire** – I love to read  
**j'aime les expériences** – I like experiments  
**j'adore le sport** – I love sport  
**le/la prof est sympa** – the teacher is nice/kind

**le/la prof est trop sévère** – the teacher is too strict

**Il est...** - it is  
**heure(s)** – o'clock/hours/time  
**et** - past  
**moins** – to/less  
**et quart** – quarter past  
**moins le quart** – quarter to  
**et demie** – half past  
**huit heures cinq** – five past 8  
**huit heures moins dix** – ten to 8  
**quinze** -15  
**vingt** - 20  
**vingt-cinq** - 25  
**à** - at  
**midi** - midday  
**minuit** - midnight  
**on commence** – we start  
**on finit** – we finish

**Pourquoi?** Why?  
**parce que** because



Use connectives to create longer sentences: **et** (and), **mais** (but), **aussi** (also).

Note the word order with **aussi**: j'aime aussi...
