As we approach the end of the first half term of this academic year, I wanted to write to you to thank you, and your children for their support and for the positive way in which they have settled into Chase Terrace Academy.

The year 7 pupils have made a fantastic start to their learning, really committing to life in secondary school. Attendance to school is always a focus and we would like to extend our thanks to you for your support in this. Good attendance has a direct link to good performance in school, so we are delighted so many of our year 7 pupils have maintained 100% attendance. Many of our pupils have joined sporting clubs, and extra-curricular activities such as Chess Club, Macramé Club, and have made the most of the opportunities that have presented them.

As I visit classes, and walk around the school, pupils are consistently working hard in lessons demonstrating high aspirations and are always polite and respectful. You may be aware that we teach a Behaviour Curriculum once a week, every week to all our pupils. This means we explicitly teach everyone what we expect this to look like. For example, when we say we expect pupils to be respectful, we teach them that this means using our manners to ask for something and saying please and thank you to staff and each other. Being respectful is about how we treat each other, and our environment so we ensure pupils know not to drop litter or be careless with school property and why this is important.

Communication is important to us as a school, and we hope that you have felt part of our school community as a result. Please remember that we have several ways of ensuring that you are aware of events and important notices including Facebook, X (formerly Twitter), Linked In, and our pupil marketing team have recently launched @CTA_TRAC on Instagram, which is produced 'for the pupils, by the pupils'.
