Dear Year 10 Parent(s)/Carer(s),

We are writing to you to outline the upcoming assessment that your child will be completing as part of their GCSE in English Language.

Spoken Language

All pupils must complete a **compulsory element** of the English Language course: Spoken Language.

For your child to achieve the highest grade in their Spoken Language assessment, we recommend that your child carefully plans and writes their speech to last **between 3 and 5 minutes**. We also recommend that your child learns as much of the speech from memory as possible, although they will be allowed to use cue cards to aid their memory. They should also consider questions that will be posed by the moderator and can carefully consider the responses ahead of the formal presentation. The Spoken Language assessment is graded at three levels, Pass, Merit and Distinction.

The pupils have started their preparation for this assessment and have been asked to work on the researching and redrafting of their speeches both in their lessons and at home. The assessments will then be completed in allocated time slots on the following days:

- Tuesday 6th May
- Wednesday 7th May
- Thursday 8th May
- Friday 9th May
- Monday 12th May
- Tuesday 13th May
- Wednesday 14th May
- Thursday 15th May
- Friday 16th May

Pupils will be given a time slot by their English teacher and pupils must ensure that they attend at the allotted time. On the day, they should leave their lesson five minutes before their time slot to ensure that they are ready for a prompt start.
