**RE : SPORTS DAY**

Our Annual Sports Day will be held on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025 for Years 7, 8, 9, 10 & 12. All pupils are required to come to school wearing their correct CTA PE kit (sportswear for year 12) and will register at 8.30am:

- Years 7 & 8 will register in their Personal Development rooms before their sports day events begin at 10.50am - 12.50pm
- Years 9 & 10 will register on the fields and complete their sports day events until 10:30am.
- Year 12 will register on the fields and will be either competing or supporting all day.
- Year 7-10 pupils will be in their Personal Development rooms completing Personal Development activities for the other time slots when they are not competing.
- All pupils will then be on the field from 1.30pm to 3pm for the finals, relays, and presentations.

The canteen will be serving food as normal at break and lunch, but it is recommended that pupils bring a packed lunch where possible. The event will finish at 3pm for the normal end of school.

To support your child on the day we wish to advise you and your child of the following information regarding PE kit: Pupils should wear regulation CTA PE kit to school (as made clear on the school website under policies) with the addition of a blue or black sports tracksuit or CTA PE Hoody for comfort if desired. Combat trousers, beach wear, cycling shorts or three-quarter length trousers etc are unacceptable attire and pupils who are not dressed appropriately will not be able to compete. When competing, pupils must wear regulation summer PE kit (without tracksuit unless medical evidence supplied). Where there are issues with obtaining CTA PE kit, can pupils please make the school aware as we have spare clothing to borrow, or the CATCH hub is available to support anyone in need.

The changing rooms will not be secured during the day and there will be no provision for collecting jewellery or valuables. Please ensure your child leaves these items at home as we cannot be responsible for any losses. In the event of a hot and sunny day your child should bring sunscreen, sensible hat, and water in a plastic container. There will be water stations provided for pupils to refill their water bottles if they wish to. If the weather is cold and/or damp; waterproof coat and trousers are recommended. If weather is extremely poor; Sports Day will unfortunately be cancelled, and pupils will have their normal timetabled lessons.

We expect our pupils to demonstrate the highest standards of behaviour at all times and represent themselves, their Personal Development group and their Houses with respect, community, tenacity and aspiration. Alternative provision will be provided for pupils unable to meet these expectations. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide

capacity for parents/family to watch but we will take photographs and publicise where consent is provided. Thank you for your support and we look forward to hosting another successful Sports Day at Chase Terrace Academy.
