RE : YEAR 13 TRIAL EXAMINATIONS

On Monday 24th November, our Year 13 students will begin their trial examinations. The examination period will last until Wednesday 3rd December and students will only be required to attend school when they have an exam. Normal lessons for Year 13 will resume on the morning of Thursday 4th December.

The main focus of the mock examinations is to provide both students and staff with an indication of where good progress is being made and where further work is needed. Students have been given further details on the examinations as well as some guidance on revision strategies. Students will of course be supported in individual subject areas with specific revision activities and this work will be set through show my homework. Planning revision is key and there is a document on the website to support this along with a range of other guidance.
