RE: YEAR 13 LEAVER'S INFORMATION LETTER

As we near the end of Year 13 study here at CTA we would like to share with you the arrangements for the examination period and leavers assembly.

All Year 13 students will attend their leavers assembly which will be at 11am on Friday 22nd May 2026 in the Sixth Form Centre. Following this assembly, Year 13 students will start their official study leave.

Post 16 examinations start on 5th May 2026. Any students who have an exam prior to 22nd May can take the day before their particular exam to study at home, should they wish, in final preparation. Other than this, students are to be in school until their leavers assembly.

Students have been given a timetable for their examinations and should arrive no later than 8.30am for morning examinations so that they can enter the exam hall by 8.45am. Students should arrive by 12.45pm for afternoon examinations so that they can start by 1pm.

It is vital that students have the correct equipment for their examinations so that they are able to access all papers. Students should ensure that they have: two black biro's, a pencil and sharpener, an eraser, a ruler and any specialist equipment required for Maths and Science papers. If they bring a pencil case, it should be clear, and with no writing on.

We request that all textbooks and locker keys are returned to the Sixth Form Centre by the student's final examination. We also take this opportunity to thank you for your support over the last 2 years, and we look forward to our final celebrations with Year 13 at the prom on Thursday 25th June 2026.

A-Level Results Day this year is on Thursday 13th August and the school will be open at 8am. Students will collect their results from the library and further details with all arrangements will be sent out towards the end of term and will be posted on our school website and social media channels.
