I am writing to inform you that students across our school will be sitting their Multi Academy Trust (MAT) aligned Science assessments on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2026**.

These assessments are an important opportunity for students to demonstrate their understanding and progress across the curriculum. The topics that will be assessed are:

- Breathing & Digestion
- Inheritance & Evolution
- Periodic Table & The Elements
- Earth's Resources & Climate
- Contact Forces & Pressure
- Light & Sound
- General science skills such as practicals and investigation skills

To support your child in preparing for these assessments, we have issued every student with a revision pack of the all the knowledge organisers for the relevant topics. We strongly encourage regular and structured revision in the coming weeks. Effective revision should involve a variety of approaches to help reinforce knowledge and build confidence.

Students may find the following strategies particularly helpful:

- Reviewing class notes, knowledge organisers and revision guides
- Using online resources such as [BBC Bitesize](#) or ['Revision Monkey' educational YouTube videos](#).
- Practising retrieval through quizzes, flashcards, and self-testing
- Breaking revision into manageable chunks over time rather than last-minute cramming
