While we hope to celebrate with as many students as possible, it is important that these expectations around attendance and behaviour are upheld to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

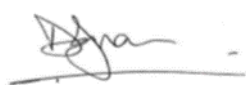
Event Details:
