Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: EXAMINATION RESULTS DAYS 2026

Sixth Form:

Results will be available at 8:00am on Thursday 13th August 2026 in the Sixth Form area. Staff will be available in school from 8:00am to support with any specific exam/careers related guidance you may require.

GCSE:

Results will be available at 9:00am on Thursday 20th August 2026 in the library. Staff will be available in school from 9:00am to support with any specific exam/careers related guidance you may require.

An envelope containing a hard copy of the Statement of Results will be available in school to collect on the day. Uncollected envelopes will be available from the school reception from Wednesday 2nd September.

Should you wish for your results to be posted out, please bring in a stamped, self-addressed envelope, and they will be posted out on results day. These cannot be posted out before 8am on this day. If candidates would like their results sent via email, please send an email to exams2026@chaseterraceacademy.co.uk from the email address to which you would like the results to go.

Results will not be given out by telephone unless by special prior agreement with the Exams Officer.

On results day, you will receive a 'Statement of Results' - this is not your final certificate. The statement lists all the exams you have taken and any components within the qualification. A capital letter indicates an overall grade. (Certificates are received in school early November, and once checked, you will be notified they are available for collection from school main reception). Those students in Year 11 who signed up to the Education Record App will receive their results later on during results day – please note that the school has no control over this and we would advise all students to come to school to collect their results so that they can access them at the earliest opportunity and receive the necessary support and guidance from staff.

POST RESULTS SERVICES:

All Reviews of Marking should first be discussed with the relevant Head of Department and/or Subject Tutor who will advise on the viability of such a request. In the school's experience, it is unusual for marks to change upwards by more than a marginal amount. However, the school reviews the marks that your child and others have achieved and will advise candidates if we feel there is an anomaly and that the paper should be reviewed.

If we are concerned about results received for a particular subject, the school itself will request a review of marking of all those papers (with the candidate's consent). It is important to note that grades can go down as well as up, and this needs to be carefully

considered when discussing a review of marking. Should you wish to proceed with a Post Results Service, the consent form and information will be included in your results envelope.

We recognise that exam season often brings a mixture of anticipation, pressure and uncertainty – not only for our students, but for their parents and carers too. These materials offer guidance on supporting your child as they wait for results day and provide practical advice to help families navigate this period with confidence.
