Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

As we prepare for the forthcoming academic year, we wish to express our appreciation for your continued support in upholding the standards and expectations of our students.

It is also a pertinent point to remind you of the uniform expectations in September. A key aspect of our uniform policy is the requirement for students to wear black polishable shoes. Please note the following important details regarding acceptable footwear:

1. Students must wear black polishable shoes with no visible logos. Branded shoes such as Nike Air Force or similar equivalents are not permitted.
2. Students who arrive at school wearing incorrect footwear will be required to change into appropriate shoes, or wear shoes provided by the school (where this can be facilitated). Refusal to comply with this expectation will result in students working separately from their peers until appropriate shoes are worn.
3. Medical Exemptions: Any request for a concession due to medical reasons must be accompanied by valid medical evidence. This documentation should clearly state the need for alternative footwear and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
4. Jewellery should be kept to a minimum, one watch (smart watches are placed in phone pouches) and one small pair of stud earrings. No facial piercings or permanent jewellery are permitted.

In addition, you will be aware, following recent correspondence, that students now have a phone pouch. All students are required to turn off their phones and lock Please inform school via the MS Form below if your child will not be bringing a phone to school.

If your child is late, they place their phone/devices in a pouch which is then confiscated and returned following a same day 30-minute detention.

The minimum expectation of student's equipment is two black pens, a pencil, and a ruler. Students are welcome to bring, a glue stick, highlighters, rubber, geometry sets. It would be helpful for students to have access to a calculator at home.
